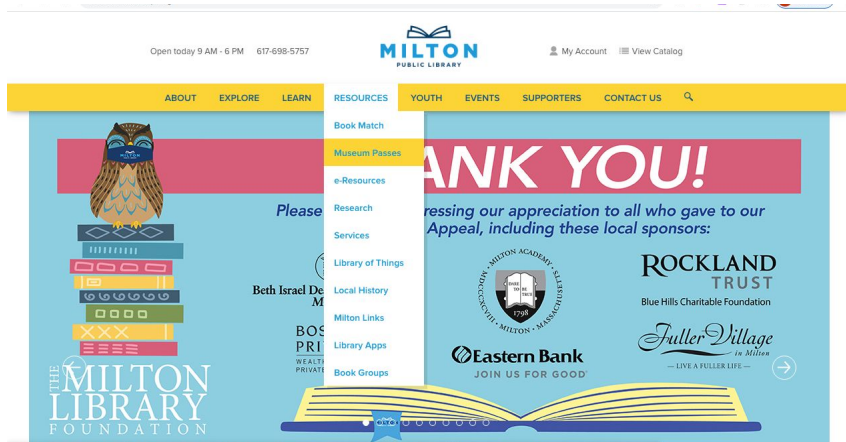


Museum Pass 101

If you are like me and love going to local museum, perhaps you should consider reserving one of the many Milton Public Library's museum passes. The Friends of the Milton Public Library has funded yearly museum memberships so that library card holders, like yourself, can visit local museums and zoos at a discount. Currently the library has passes to the Institute of Contemporary Art, Isabella Stewart Gardiner Museum, Peabody Essex Museum, the New England Aquarium, Museum of Fine Arts, Zoo New England (Franklin Park and Stone Zoo), Plimoth Patuxet and Heritage Museum and Gardens.

To reserve a museum pass, visit the homepage of the Milton Public Library. Then hover over the word "resources" which will force a drop down menu (see below) and then move your cursor down to choose "Museum Passes." You will then be brought to a page that will ask you to choose a date for the day you want to use the pass. If the pass is available you will need to click on the "request pass" button and if it is booked it will say "booked". Once you choose request pass, you will then be brought to a page where you will need to enter in your library card number. Next you will be able to choose if you

want a reminder or not via email or text. Don't forget to read the whole page so you can make sure your pass is submitted. You will also need to visit the library to get the actual pass with instructions on how to use the discount on your entrance fee. Due to COVID, capacity is limited so museums require you to choose a specific entry time in a advance. Where will
