
Stone Zoo Review By Barbara Fritz-Elliott

This animal is a domestic breed of cattle originating in South Asia. They are well adapted to withstand high temperatures and are farmed throughout the tropics. They are used as drought oxen, dairy cattle, and as beef cattle, as well as for byproducts such as hides and dung for fuel and manure.
